You are likely to continue receiving messages from organizations with which you do business, and others. To protect your information, it is important whether you opt out or not that you always maintain a high level of awareness and guard yourself against scams, fraud, and identity theft. *When in doubt, tear it up, hang it up, and delete the email!*

About Opt-Out Services

As a consumer, you have a say in how many solicitations you receive via telephone, the Postal Service, and even online.

There are three main ways consumers can opt out of receiving commercial phone calls, mailings and emails. They are:

- Do Not Call Registry
- DMAchoice™
- Email Preference Service (eMPS)

If you choose to take advantage of any opt-out service, MCPD recommends that you make it a habit to renew your opt-out status once a year when you access your annual free credit report.
