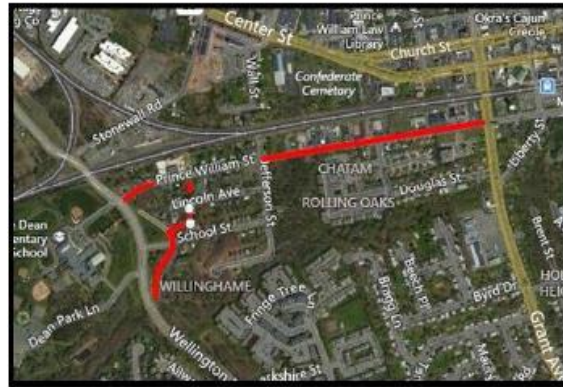


T-019 PRINCE WILLIAM STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT CITIZENS MEETING

History

- Project Introduced in 2000
- Prince William Street Citizens Advisory Committee Recommendations September 2014
 - Narrow right-of-way from Wellington Road to Jefferson Street to avoid cemetery
 - Storm outfall to Winters Branch
 - Bike Lanes on both sides of Prince William Street
 - Minimize on street parking
- Total Cost Estimate \$9.2 Million
- Coordinated Effort Between Public Works Department and Utilities Department

Goals

- Improve pedestrian and bike traffic safety
- Enhance Overall Street Appearance
- Improve neighborhood drainage
- Upsize water mains for better water quality and fire protection
- Enhance sanitary sewer reliability
- Improve Electric and Communications Reliability by Undergrounding

Proposed Design

- New Street Lighting
- Curb and gutter with 5 foot bike lanes on both sides of the road
- No on street parking except at the Gregory Building (north side) and at the Courts at Historic Manassas (south side)
- Sidewalk on the south side from Grant Avenue to Wellington Road and on the north side from Grant Avenue to Jefferson Street
- New pedestrian signals at Wellington Road
- Cemetery to remain undisturbed
- New Water Lines on Prince William Street, Westfield Road, and Douglas Road
- Storm outflow from American Legion building to Winters Branch

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What's Happening

- Undergrounding of Electric, Comcast, and Verizon utilities completed
- Columbia Gas continuing work to upgrade main and connect service lines
- Demolition at 9524 Prince William Street
- Finalization of engineering plans

What to Expect

- Begin Construction – October 2017 (Weather Dependent)
- Construction Hours 8:00 AM - 5:00 PM M-F
- 12-18 Month Project Duration
- Through Traffic Will be Limited During Construction
- Continual Access to Your Property
- Trash Service Will Continue
- Announced Brief Water and Sanitary Sewer Service Disruptions will Occur
- During Construction, On-Street Parking Will be Limited
