### **NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES PROGRAM: OVERVIEW**

The Neighborhood Services Program was established in 2006 to implement the City Council's goal of improving the livability of neighborhoods and to ensure better communication between residents and City staff. The mission of the Neighborhood Services office is to maintain a unified community in which people of all backgrounds are active in their community and work well together to build strong and thriving neighborhoods and an unmatched quality of life. The Neighborhood Services Coordinator is in the Office of Community Development and has the following role:

#### **LIAISON**

- Facilitate fair and open communication between the City and neighborhoods
- Assist City departments with communicating decisions on key issues to neighborhoods
- Encourage conversations between the City and neighborhoods

#### **RESOURCE**

- Help neighborhoods develop and implement projects
- Receive concerns from residents and coordinate responses with City staff
- Provide training and other information sharing opportunities to educate residents

### **ADVOCATE**

- Work with City departments to ensure that the information provided by neighborhoods is given full consideration
- Facilitate neighborhood involvement in public processes
- Help City departments to improve outreach to neighborhoods

### **CITY OF MANASSAS E-GOVERNMENT SERVICES**

The City of Manassas offers around-the-clock access to many City services via the Web site [www.manassascity.org](http://www.manassascity.org). You can pay your personal property taxes and parking tickets online. In a click of a button, register for Recreation Programs in minutes by viewing from a list of classes and activities. Below is a summary of other popular and frequently used online services.

### **ONLINE MAPPING**

The City's Geographic Information System (GIS) is accessible at <http://gisweb.ci.manassas.va.us/gis/>. This application provides convenient access to basic property ownership information and aerial photography of the City.

**RESIDENTS SERVICE REQUEST**

The City of Manassas residents can submit a non-emergency request online that will help us identify a problem in your area -- and fix it fast. For example, residents can give a brief description of the problem or comment by filling out the form. The query will be sent to the appropriate City department.

**E-APPLICATIONS**

For your convenience, various forms and applications are available online at [www.manassascity.org](http://www.manassascity.org). The goal of e-applications is to move government services directly to the citizens. Applications are in PDF format and require Adobe Acrobat Reader to view them.
