

Commercial Vehicle - Parking

Question:

If I cannot park my commercial vehicle in the residential district where can I park it?

Answer:

Commercial vehicles may be parked in a legally designed industrial or commercial storage yard or overnight in an otherwise legal parking space on a public street **in a B-Commercial or I-Industrial District**

Areas zoned B-Commercial or I-Industrial where overnight commercial vehicle parking is permitted include:

- Center Street between Lee and Fairview Ave.
- Digges Rd. north less and except the cul-de-sac adjacent to the apartments
- Euclid Ave. - from City/County line near school to Toms Trucking and Tower Hill. (Past that point by the apartments is residential.)
- Quarry Rd. from Euclid Ave. intersection to County Line
- Prince William Street – north side only
- Richmond Ave. – between Signal Hill and Liberia – east-side only
- West Street – between Lee and Prince William Street
- Battle Street – between Quarry and Prince William Street
- Main Street – between Quarry and Prince William Street
