
Electronic vs Electric

What's the difference?

<u>Electronic</u> items are devices that have transistors/chips that are used to manipulate the electric current running through a device such as cell phones, tv's, laptops, computers, cameras, scanners, ZIP drives, keyboards, printers, video game systems, etc. These types of items contain hazardous waste and should be taken to one of the City of Manassas scheduled drop-off events.

<u>Electric</u> items consist of items that use electricity as energy to hear, light, or provide some type of motion such as a toaster, vacuum cleaner, lamp, fan, etc. These types of items DO NOT contain hazardous waste and can be put out with the regular trash.
