**Largest Basic Recruit School in Manassas City Police
Department's History Graduates**

The Northern Virginia Criminal Justice Training Academy Basic Law Enforcement 125th Session graduated on Monday, December 19, 2011 at the George Mason University Concert Hall, 4400 University Drive, in Fairfax. Comprised of nine recruits, this is the largest class to graduate in the department's history.

The 26 week long basic law enforcement school is divided into four modules. They are Criminal Investigation, Legal, Patrol and Skills. Recruits must meet three separate proficiency standards in order to successfully complete the school. Standards include attaining a minimum cumulative grade average in each of the four modules, successfully passing all state-mandated objectives and criteria and successfully completing all performance-based tests, which include major components such as First-Aid, CPR, Defensive Tactics, Firearms and Driver Training courses.
