According to victims in each incident, unknown suspect(s) went through vehicles and opened glove boxes, center consoles and other compartments. Cash, portable electronics, tools and prescription medications were among the items reported stolen. In the majority of cases, the vehicles were unlocked or thought to be locked at the time of the thefts. In several instances, the vehicles were parked in the front of victims' residences where outside lights had been left off.

Larcenies from vehicles and larcenies of motor vehicle parts are the most commonly reported property offenses in the City of Manassas. Citizen reports of larcenies from vehicles resulted in 30 calls for service for the City of Manassas Police Department since January 1, 2013 alone. Despite these statistics, it is one of the easiest crimes to prevent if you follow some simple tips, available in today's Public Service Announcement "Larcenies from Vehicles."
