Robbery - Arrest

On Thursday, March 21, at approximately 7:12PM, Manassas City Police officers responded to a report of a fight on the 8900 block of Nicol Lane. They discovered a juvenile victim who had been robbed by possible gang members. Several suspects were located and detained in the area. One had a BB-gun pistol. The investigation led to the arrest of one adult and four juveniles who are between 14 and 15 years old. The juveniles were taken to the Juvenile Detention Home. The adult was Jonathan Garcia Planas, 18, of 9316 Taney Road. He was charged with Robbery, Use of a Firearm in Commission of a Felony, and five counts of Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor. He is currently being held at the ADC with no bond, pending a May 3 court appearance.

Larceny from Auto, Fraud

The Manassas City Police Department is investigating the larceny of items (and resulting fraud) from a car parked on the 9500 block of Tapok Drive. A resident reported to police that the larceny occurred sometime between Wednesday the 13th of March and Friday the 15th of March. The car was left unlocked. A debit card, a calculator and a GPS were stolen from the car. The debit card was subsequently fraudulently used at a local retail store.

The Manassas City Police Department is investigating the larceny of items from a car parked near the intersection of Digges Road and Devonshire Court. A resident reported to police that the larceny occurred sometime between Saturday, March 23, at 10:30PM and Sunday, March 24, at 10:00AM. The car was left unlocked. A laptop computer was reported missing.
