Robbery - Arrest

At approximately 9:30PM Friday, April 26, Manassas City Police officers responded to a report of two disorderly customers at the '7-Eleven' at 8402 Digges Road. Upon further investigation, it was discovered that, during an argument, Mr. Pyos had forcefully taken property from the other man. Larry Pyos, Jr., 31, of Burke, was arrested and charged with Robbery. He was held at the ADC with no bond pending a June 25 court appearance.




