Manassas City Police Department Launches New Facebook Page

The Manassas City Police Department launched its very own Facebook page today. The agency dove headfirst onto the social media stage with a “Throw Back Thursday” message posted by Chief Doug Keen himself. In his post, Chief Keen says that in the true spirit of the Department’s “citywide community policing philosophy,” he wants the new page “to be informative and helpful” for the community.

The new page will allow for increased two-way communication with citizens. While Facebook is not intended to be a place where citizens should report crime or emergencies, the Department hopes to open the lines of communication with the community by using social media as a tool.

The new page will serve as a source of timely information about events, crime prevention tips, training opportunities, incident reports, and other highlights about the Police Department and Manassas community. The Department also plans to utilize Facebook to broadcast up-to-date emergency alerts and crime bulletins that help keep citizens informed and safe, and that help bolster the public’s assistance in closing unsolved cases.
