Larceny

On November 8, 2013 Manassas City Police met with a resident on the **9200 block of Bayberry Ave with regard to a larceny. According to the victim, someone(s) broke into his trailer sometime between 8:00PM on November 7 and 9:00AM on November 8 and stole miscellaneous gas-powered landscaping tools. The combined value of all the stolen items was estimated at over \$2,000.00.**

Vandalism

At approximately 3:30PM on November 11, 2013 Manassas City Police responded to Seton School, located at 9314 Maple St, in reference to a vandalism. **According to the reporting party, someone(s) had spray painted the side of the building facing Zebedee St.**

Burglary

On November 9, 2013 Manassas City Police responded to the 10100 block of Makelys Way for a report of burglary. **According to the victim, someone(s) broke into the residence sometime between 11:00AM and 8:00PM the same day and stole miscellaneous items valued together at over \$400,000.00.**

This is an ongoing investigation.

Larceny

At approximately 2:40PM on November 10, 2013 Manassas City Police responded to Manassas Baptist Church, located at 8730 Sudley Rd, in reference to a larceny that had just occurred. **According to the reporting party, someone(s) stole his Gibson guitar off a table in a main hallway following an event at the church. The guitar was valued at approximately \$2,600.00.**

This is an ongoing investigation.

Larceny

On November 9, 2013 Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 8100 block of Sudley Rd for a report of a larceny and stolen firearm.

According to the reporting party, someone(s) stole his Taurus handgun out of his vehicle while it was parked on Battle St near Church St sometime between 8:15PM and 1:00AM the evening of November 8.

This is an ongoing investigation.

Vandalism

At approximately 8:30PM on November 8, 2013 Manassas City Police responded to a business located at 9105 Center St for a possible burglary **in progress**. Upon arrival, Officers discovered that the glass in the front of the store had been shattered, leaving an opening large enough for someone(s) to fit through. The business was vacant and no suspects were located within.

Distribution of Child Pornography - Arrest

Manassas City Police Investigators, in conjunction with the Northern Virginia-District of Columbia Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force (NOVA/DC ICAC), concluded a weeklong investigation into the distribution of child pornography over the internet last Friday with the arrest of Joshua Craig Harris.

Harris, 32, of no fixed address was arrested on November 8, 2013 and charged with six felonies pertaining to the possession and distribution of child pornography after he was identified while actively using a public network to facilitate the exchange of child pornography at Prince William County Central Community Library, located at 9601 Mathis Ave.

Harris was held at the Prince William County Adult Detention Center with no bond. His court date is yet to be determined.

Hit and Run - Arrest

At approximately 10:30PM on November 10, 2013 Manassas City Police were flagged down by a citizen who reported a hit and run that had occurred on Hastings Rd near Racquet Cir. According to the reporting party, a red Toyota Tercel had crashed head-on into a telephone pole at the intersection, causing damage estimated at \$5,000.00. When the witness approached the vehicle to speak with the driver, the driver collected his belongings and fled the scene.

Fredy Antonio Iraheta Vasquez (26) of Sterling, VA was located at the intersection of Farmington Ct and Hastings Dr and arrested for Hit and Run, Reckless Driving, and Driving on a Revoked License. Vasquez was held on a secured bond of \$6,000.00 and has a pending court date of January 6, 2014.

Reckless Driving - Arrest

At approximately 7:20PM on November 10, 2013 Manassas City Police were flagged down by a citizen who reported a hit and run that had occurred in the area of Prince William St and Wellington Rd. Upon arrival, Officers spoke with the victim who reported that his vehicle was hit from behind by a silver van whose driver had already fled the scene. Damage to the victim's vehicle is estimated at \$1,500.00. The victim sustained non life-threatening injuries.

Jose Antonio Urbina (42) of 9446 Scarlet Oak Dr was located at his residence and charged with Felony Hit and Run and Reckless Driving. He was held on a \$1,500.00 secured bond and has a pending court date of January 6, 2014.
