**Burglary**

On January 7, 2014 Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 9000 block of Sandalwood Dr for a report of a burglary. According to the reporting party, someone(s) forced entry into the residence sometime between 11:15AM and 7:20PM and stole several items including an Xbox 360, HP Compaq laptop, and a bottle of prescription medication.

**Larceny from Vehicle**

On January 8, 2014 Manassas City Police met with a citizen at “Taco Bell” located at 8891 Centreville Rd in reference to a larceny. According to the reporting party, someone(s) stole a black travel suitcase containing a cell phone tower scanner out of the bed of his pickup truck while it was parked in an adjacent parking lot between approximately 7:00PM and 7:30PM. The reporting party told Officers that the scanner would only be of use to his company and not a regular citizen, and was valued between \$5,000.00 and \$10,000.00.

**Stolen Auto**

On January 8, 2014 Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 9700 block of Clark Pl in reference to a stolen vehicle. According to the complainant, the victim’s work truck had been taken from the parking lot at the residence on January 7, 2014.

**Robbery**

At approximately 10:15PM on January 8, 2014 Manassas City Police responded to “Giant Food” located at 10100 Dumfries Rd in reference to a robbery. According to the victim, the suspect entered the vehicle in which she and two children were sitting through the unlocked driver side, displayed a large pocket knife, and demanded money. The victim complied, giving the suspect her purse. The

suspect then exited the vehicle and fled on foot in a westerly direction towards “PNC Bank.” The purse contained several items to include personal identification documents and bank cards. Neither the victim nor the children in the vehicle were harmed.

*Suspect description:* Black male, approximately 40 years old, clean shaven with a close haircut. Seen at the time of the robbery wearing a black stocking cap with a red stripe around the band, jeans, and an all black wool-style jacket

**Malicious Wounding – Arrest**

On January 9, 2014 Manassas City Police with the assistance of the Northern Virginia Regional Gang Task Force (NVGTF) and Prince William County Police concluded an investigation into an assault that took place on December 22, 2013 at “Don Julio Restaurant” (9007 Centreville Rd). Misael Alvarez Puentes (25) of 117 Polk Dr, Manassas Park, was taken into custody without incident on the 6000 block of Gholson Bridge Ct, Manassas (20112) and charged with malicious wounding, use of a firearm in commission of a felony, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, and brandishing. Mr. Alvarez Puentes has a pending court date of March 19, 2014.

**Aggravated Assault**

At approximately 1:30PM on December 22, 2013 Manassas City Police responded to “Don Julio Restaurant” located at 9007 Centreville Rd for a report of an assault. According to the victim, he was sitting at the bar inside the restaurant when a male subject approached him and brandished a firearm. Two more male subjects then struck him from behind and a fight ensued. The victim was transported to an area hospital where he was treated for non-life-threatening injuries.
