Larcenies from Auto

At approximately 4:00AM on April 5, 2014 Manassas City Police was dispatched to the 9300 block of Sumner Lake Blvd for a vandalism. The reporting party told officers when they arrived that he had been awakened at approximately 3:35AM by loud noises outside his window. When he looked outside, he witnessed a male subject going through a parked vehicle on Sumner Lake Blvd with a flashlight. When confronted by the witness, the suspect fled on foot. A short foot pursuit ensued between the suspect and the witness, during which time the suspect dropped several stolen items from his possession that the reporting party and officers later recovered. Upon further investigation, officers determined that two vehicles parked on the 9300 block of Sumner Lake Blvd and one on the 8300 block of Gaither St had their passenger side windows broken out and several items stolen from within. Among the stolen items were women's designer purses, a gym bag with miscellaneous items, a GPS unit, and books.

Description of Suspect: Hispanic male with full black hair. Yellow shirt under a blue "Member's Only"-style jacket, blue jeans, and black athletic shoes.

Malicious Wounding – Arrest

At approximately 10:20PM on April 5, 2014 Manassas City Police was dispatched to Don Julio Restaurant located at 9007 Centreville Rd for a report of shots being fired. Upon arrival, officers encountered two victims outside the business. The first victim, a 40-year-old male, was located on the ground in the business's parking lot, unconscious and bleeding profusely from the head. Officers immediately initiated treatment for the first victim, who was then attended to by Rescue personnel and flown to a local hospital. The second victim, a 36-year-old male, was found conscious and bleeding from the face. The second victim underwent treatment for non-life-threatening injuries on-scene and was able to tell officers what had transpired. The victim told officers that at approximately 10:15PM, he had been working security for Don Julio Restaurant when he attempted to escort the two male suspects, who appeared to be intoxicated, out of the restaurant. The two suspects became very disorderly and aggressive, then attacked the victim. The suspects grabbed a portable metal detector from the victim's duty belt to use it against him and also attempted to disarm him of his firearm. The firearm was knocked to the ground where the victim regained control of it, distanced himself from the suspects, and shot three rounds towards the ground. The two suspects then fled in a red 2003 GMC Envoy, speeding through the parking lot and striking both victims before either could move out of the way.

Upon further investigation, Manassas City Detectives were able to identify the suspects as Nahum Nehemais ESPINA VELASQUEZ, 29, of 9490 Blackhawk Dr, Manassas Park, VA 20111, and Onan Esau ESPINA VELASQUEZ, 32, of 9435 Blackhawk Dr, Manassas Park, VA 20111. With the assistance of City of Manassas Park Police, both suspects were located at 9490 Blackhawk Dr, Manassas Park, where they were apprehended without incident. Each suspect was charged with two counts of hit and run, one count of robbery, and one count of malicious wounding. Nahum ESPINA VELASQUEZ and Onan ESPINA VELASQUEZ were both held without bond and have a pending court date of May 6, 2014.

Assault & Battery – Arrest

At approximately 2:00AM on March 22, 2014 Manassas City Police responded to Mackey’s American Pub located at 9412 Main St for a physical fight. Upon arrival, officers met with the victim, a 31-year-old male, who had been punched in the head and knocked to the ground. Witnesses identified two suspects at the restaurant who were involved in the fight and who did not cooperate with officers’ questioning. At the time of being interviewed, the victim refused medical attention. However, officers were later notified that the victim had fallen unconscious a few hours after the fight and had to be transported to a local hospital, where it was determined he had sustained serious head trauma. Upon further investigation into the incident, officers identified the offender to be Joshua Allen COOK, 24, of no fixed address. On April 7, 2014 COOK was apprehended in Culpeper, VA by Virginia State Police, and has a pending court date in Prince William County.

Intent to Distribute Marijuana – Arrest

At approximately 1:30AM on April 3, 2014 a Manassas City Police Officer received a tip that the smell of burnt marijuana was coming from a guest room at Super 8 Manassas located at 8691 Phoenix Dr. Upon arrival, officers were able to substantiate the tip when they smelled marijuana emanating out of the room, and asked tenants to open the door. When the suspects opened the door, officers were able to view evidence of illegal drug activity and prostitution in plain sight. Brian Lamont RICHEY, 25, of 13970 Rockland Village Dr, Chantilly, VA 20155 was charged with prostitution and released on a summons. He has a pending court date of May 13, 2014. Marcus Alejo GARCIA, 20, of 13394 Caballero Way, Clifton, VA 20124 was arrested without incident and transported to the Adult Detention Center. In the course of their investigation, officers had discovered the marijuana in the room belonged to GARCIA and that he also intended to sell a large quantity of which he was already in possession.

GARCIA was charged with solicitation of prostitution and possession with intent to distribute marijuana. He was held on a \$2,500 secured bond and has a pending court date of May 13, 2014.
