Stolen Trailer

On April 8, 2014 Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 9700 block of Brent St for a report of a stolen motor vehicle. The victim told officers that during the evening of April 8th before approximately 7:00PM, someone(s) stolen his homemade trailer from outside his residence.

Larceny

On April 7, 2014 Manassas City Police met with a citizen on the 9900 block of Leander Ln for a report of a larceny. The reporting party told officers that on various dates since January 1, 2014, he had discovered that garage door remotes had been stolen from numerous homes in the neighborhood that were under construction. The thefts were discovered piecemeal at the time of final walk-throughs on the 8800 block of Bentfield Dr, 9900 block of Fendall St, 8700 and 9900 blocks of Libeau Dr, 10000 block of Wellington Rd, and the 9900 block of Leander Ln.

Disorderly Conduct – Arrest

At approximately 12:40AM on April 6, 2014 Manassas City Police were patrolling the area of El Rincon Salvadoreno located at 9015 Centreville Rd when they observed a Hispanic male urinating on the back steps of the establishment. The offender ran on foot when officers confronted him. The owner of the restaurant informed Police that the offender had also left without paying his bill. Shortly thereafter, officers observed the offender leaving the restaurant parking lot in a 2005 Suzuki Aerio, driving southbound on Route 28 at a high rate of speed and without headlights. A short vehicle pursuit ensued before the suspect's vehicle was found crashed in the area of Portner Ave and Maple St. The offender, Uriel GOMEZ-FLORES, had escaped on foot prior to officers' arrival. Upon further investigation, officers were able to identify the owner of the vehicle and the location of his residence. The suspect was located at the vehicle owner's residence attempting to flee from Police on foot once more. GOMEZ-FLORES, 28, of 9440 Taney Rd, was detained and charged with intoxicated in public, escape without force, reckless driving, driving without a license, eluding police, hit and run, and disorderly conduct. He was held on a \$5,000.00 bond and has a pending court date of June 17, 2014.
