Vandalism

On April 10, 2014 Manassas City Police was dispatched to the 8600 block of Point of Woods Dr for two reports of vandalism. The first reporting party told officers that between 3:15PM and 4:45PM on April 10th the hood of their vehicle had been severely scratched by what appeared to be a key. The vehicle was parked in front of the victims' residence at the time of the vandalism. The second reporting party told officers that his vehicle was also parked in front of his residence when the hood was severely scratched between 3:30PM and 6:30PM on April 10th.

Hit & Run – Arrest

On April 11, 2014 Manassas City Police was dispatched to the 9000 block of Centreville Rd in reference to a hit and run involving a motorcycle. Upon arrival, officers learned that the accused, Felix Alexander GAINES, was under the influence of alcohol when he test-drove a 2012 Kawasaki motorcycle from Manassas Honda Kawasaki Suzuki, causing \$1,000.00 in damage to the motorcycle and \$100.00 to a street sign. GAINES, 49, of 13065 Sterling Point Dr, Gainesville, VA 20155 was charged with reckless driving and hit and run. He has a pending court date of May 7, 2014.

Assault – Arrest

On April 13, 2014 Manassas City Police responded to the intersection of Center St and Main St for a fight in progress. Upon arrival, officers encountered the accused actively fighting among a large group of individuals. In the process of fighting, Luis Alonzo ESCOBAR punched the victim, a 30-year-old female, as she walked past on the sidewalk, causing non-life-threatening injuries to her face. ESCOBAR, 22, of 8109 Cobden Ct #102, Manassas (20109) was charged with assault and resisting arrest and held on a \$1,500.00 bond. His court date is unavailable.

Disorderly Conduct – Arrest

On April 13, 2014 Manassas City Police was dispatched to El Rincon Salvadoreno located at 9015 Centreville Rd for a report of an assault and battery. In the process of obtaining information, officers were notified by a patron that a physical fight was taking place inside the business. Upon entering the restaurant, officers discovered a group of individuals preparing to fight with tables and chairs being pushed out of the way. When officers attempted to detain the main offender, Alberto NAVARRETE, he resisted arrest until officers could gain control of him. NAVARRETE, 43, of 9636 Remington Rd, Manassas (20109) was charged with disorderly conduct, intoxicated in public, and resisting arrest. He was held on a \$1,000.00 bond and has a pending court date of May 13, 2014.
