Burglary


On May 9, 2014 Manassas City Police met with citizens at Weisco Signs & Awards, located at 9073 Liberia Ave, for a report of a past burglary. Business employees told officers that earlier in the morning they discovered the front glass door had been shattered and a register containing an undisclosed amount of cash stolen. Officers were able to recover the register out of a nearby dumpster but the cash was missing. The theft occurred sometime between 5:00PM on May 8th and 7:50AM on May 9th.

Assault & Battery – Arrest

At approximately 6:50AM on May 9, 2014 Manassas City Police were conducting a routine traffic stop on the 9100 block of Taney Rd when the riders of the vehicle became combatant with officers. After refusing to comply with officers' commands, officers asked the driver, Philip Austin TRACEY to exit the vehicle to be detained for safety reasons. TRACEY initially complied but proceeded to pull away from officers' grasp and attempted to strike the officers. TRACEY, 24, of 9708 Pickett Ln was charged with obstruction by threat, obstruction by force, and assault on a law enforcement officer. He was held without bond and has a pending court date of July 22, 2014.
