Assault & Battery – Arrest

On June 2, 2014 Manassas City Police met with two residents at Hastings Marketplace Shopping Center for a report of an assault. Upon arrival, officers discovered that the reporting parties were involved in a road rage incident in the area that escalated at the intersection of Liberia Ave and Euclid Ave. When stopped at the intersection, the suspect, Joseph E. PULLEN, exited his vehicle and became verbally confrontational with the victim. PULLEN then struck the victim, a 51-year-old male of Nokesville, twice in the face before the victim could exit his vehicle. The victim sustained minor injuries. PULLEN, 36, of 7205 Opal Rd, Warrenton, VA 20186 was charged with assault and battery and held on a \$5,000.00 bond. He has a pending court date of June 24, 2014.
