Larcenies from Fireworks Stands

On June 26, 2014 Manassas City Police Department responded to a fireworks stand located at 9221 Sudley Rd for a report of a larceny. The stand employee told officers that at approximately 9:30PM that evening she stepped away for a brief moment and during that time, someone took an undisclosed amount of cash from the cash register on the counter. The employee had taken note of two males acting suspiciously prior to the incident.

Description of suspects: (1) White male, 40yo, 5'8", 160lbs, with black/graying, medium-length hair. Wearing a black baseball cap and a black t-shirt with a race-track design on it. (2) White male in his 30s, 5'8", 160lbs, with dark hair, a buzz cut, and acne scarring. Wearing a dark t-shirt and shorts and riding a BMX-style bicycle, dark in color.

On June 29, 2014 Manassas City Police responded to another fireworks stand located at 10159 Hastings Dr for a report of a larceny that occurred at approximately 2:40PM. The stand employee told officers that at this location, a male subject inquired about merchandise and when the employee went to the back to retrieve it, he removed the cash register from the counter and ran with it through the shopping center towards Manassas Mill Apartments.

Description of suspect: White male in his early 30s, approximately 5'9" with a skinny build, a pale complexion, light brown hair, and no facial hair. Wearing a white or gray hat and a white or gray t-shirt.

Road Rage Incident – Warrants Obtained

On June 27, 2014 Manassas City Police met with a resident for a report of road rage. The victim told officers that at approximately 11:15PM the same evening as she left the Taco Bell located at 8891 Centreville Rd, another vehicle almost struck her vehicle near the Burger King located at 8889 Centreville Rd. The driver and the passenger, two males, began to scream obscenities at her and her passengers. The victim drove off immediately southbound on Liberia Ave. The victim told officers that she noticed the same suspect vehicle was following her very closely on Liberia Ave near Euclid Ave and almost struck her vehicle, causing her to pull over. Once stopped, the suspect vehicle also stopped and one of the suspects approached her vehicle, striking the hood of her car with a baseball bat. Using the description provided by witnesses and the suspect's vehicle registration, officers were able to locate the driver of the suspect vehicle at a residence in Prince William County. Warrants were obtained against Gabriel RODRIGUEZ, 19, of 8025 McLean St, Manassas, VA 20111 for driving on a suspended license and aggressive driving. He has a pending court date of August 26, 2014.
