

**Manassas City Police Department
Crime Report
February 2, 2015**

Burglary

On January 31, 2015, Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 9000 block of Centreville Rd in reference to a burglary. The victim told officers that sometime between 7:40PM on January 30th and 3:00AM on January 31st, someone had entered the residence and stolen several items valued together at approximately \$1,000.00. There were no signs of forced entry.

Attempted Burglary

On January 31, 2015, Manassas City Police responded to BB&T Bank, located at 8650 Centreville Rd, for a report of an attempted burglary. The reporting party told officers that between the time the bank closed on January 30th and the time it reopened at 9:00AM on January 31st, someone had pried open the side door of the drive-through automated teller machine (ATM). No money was removed from the ATM.

Larceny/Brandishing *UPDATE* – Arrest

On February 2, 2015, Manassas City Police concluded a nearly five-week-long investigation into a series of crimes which led to the identification of Clayton Lee HILL as a suspect in the purse-snatching and brandishing incident that occurred at Giant Food (10100 Dumfries Rd) on December 31, 2014. HILL (52) of 22060 Waverly Heights Rd, Middleburg, VA 20117, who had been charged by Manassas City Police for the robbery of BB&T Bank that occurred on January 7th, is in custody at Rappahannock Shenandoah Warren Regional Jail following his arrest by Virginia State Police on January 10th. HILL has a pending court date of February 19, 2015 in Prince William General District Court. Please see prior releases and the attached bulletin below for more information.

Larceny/Brandishing [Released on December 31, 2014]


At approximately 10:00PM on December 30, 2014, Manassas City Police responded to Giant Food, located at 10100 Dumfries Rd, for a report of a larceny that had just occurred. The victim, a 48-year-old female of Manassas, told officers that an unknown male stole her purse containing her smart phone, wallet, and other personal items from her shopping cart and ran towards the store exit. A store employee chased the suspect and when he was within two to three feet of him, the suspect turned around and displayed a handgun in his waistband before fleeing in an unknown direction of travel.

Robbery – Arrest [Released on January 12, 2015]

On January 9, 2015, investigative leads resulted in the identification of Clayton Lee HILL as a suspect in the robbery of BB&T Bank (9201 Church St) that occurred on January 7, 2015 (see previous release below). With the assistance of the Town of Woodstock Police Department, Shenandoah County Sheriff's Office, United States Marshals Service, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation, HILL was arrested by Virginia State Police in Woodstock, VA after a short pursuit shortly before 9:00AM on January 10, 2015. HILL (52), of 22060 Waverly Heights Ln, Middleburg, VA 20117, was charged with robbery and is awaiting transport back to Prince William County where he has a pending court date in General District Court.

Robbery [Released on January 7, 2015]

At approximately 3:30PM on January 7, 2015, a male suspect entered the BB&T Bank (9201 Church St) and demanded money. A weapon was not displayed, however was implied. The teller complied and the suspect fled the scene on foot with an undisclosed amount of cash.

Assault and Battery – Arrest

At approximately 11:30PM on January 30, 2015, Manassas City Police responded to El Damazo Restaurant, located at 10444 Dumfries Rd, for a report of disorderly subjects in front of the business.



Upon arrival, officers observed a male subject striking the on-site security guard in the torso. It was learned through further investigation that the suspect, Javier Armando OSORTO-GUEVARA, had been disorderly inside the restaurant and kept attempting reentry after being escorted out by security.

OSORTO-GUERVARA (32) of 7641 McDowell Ct, Dumfries, VA 22026 was charged with drunk in public and assault and battery. He was held on a \$3,500.00 bond and has a pending court date of March 17, 2015.

Destruction of Property – Arrest

During the morning hours of January 31, 2015, Manassas City Police met with the owner of In & Out Mart, located at 8930 Ashton Ave, for a report of a destruction of property. Upon further investigation, officers discovered that at approximately 5:30AM the same morning, a male subject had thrown himself into the front glass doors, shattering them and causing approximately \$1,500.00 in damage. No entry was made into the business. Subsequently, officers arrested a man who proved to be the same subject at a nearby 7-Eleven (8901 Godwin Dr) for intoxicated in public. For the incident at In and Out Mart, Brett A. EDGAR (31) of 187 Cabbel Dr, Manassas Park, VA 20111 was also charged with unlawful entry and felony destruction of property. EDGAR was held on a \$4,000.00 bond and has a pending court date of March 3, 2015. [No Photo Available]

On Thursday, January 29, 2015 detectives conducted a follow up interview with Hill, who is incarcerated on the BB&T Bank Robbery charge from January 7, 2015. The interview resulted in Hill being confirmed as the offender in the larceny of the purse and he was subsequently charged with Grand Larceny.

On Tuesday, December 30, 2014 at approximately 10:00pm, a 48 year old female was shopping inside of the Giant Food Store (10100 Dumfries Rd) and placed her purse inside her shopping cart. The suspect pictured above passed by her quickly and grabbed her purse, then ran out of the store.

SUSPECT DESCRIPTION:

Black male, some facial hair, heavy build, wearing gray sweat pants and a black stocking/skull cap.
