Indecent Exposure

At approximately 4:50PM on June 1, 2015, Manassas City Police responded to GMC (9964 Liberia Ave) in reference to an indecent exposure that had just occurred. The victim, a 41-year-old woman of the Manassas area of Prince William County, told officers that after leaving the store, she sat in her vehicle to make a phone call. While on the phone, a male suspect parked closely next to her vehicle and began to expose himself and make inappropriate gestures in her field of sight. He then left the area in his vehicle towards Prince William Pkwy.

Description of suspect: 35-45 year old male with salt-and-pepper hair and a blue t-shirt

Description of suspect vehicle: Newer model, blue Chevrolet Silverado pickup truck

Breaking and Entering

At approximately 5:45PM on June 2, 2015, Manassas City Police responded to the 9200 block of Timberwood Ct in reference to a breaking and entering that had just occurred. The reporting party told officers that she had been watching television when she heard someone force his way through the rear door. The victim then saw the suspect attempting to open a second door to enter further into the residence but fled out the back when he saw she had noticed him. The victim exited out the front of the residence and observed the suspect running westbound on Weems Rd towards Stonewall Rd before turning left on Stonewall Rd towards Sudley Rd.

Description of suspect: Black male, mid-20s, 5'11" with a thin build, medium-length hair. Wearing a black The North Face-style jacket and dark pants.
