**Attempted Fraud**

On August 26, 2015, Manassas City Police received multiple reports from citizens who said someone had called them, claiming to be from the U.S. Department of Treasury. The caller claimed to be a Treasury agent who states the resident is behind on his taxes and needs to contact the caller as soon as possible to avoid felony warrants. The victims did not comply. **Stolen Auto**

On August 21, 2015, Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 9800 block of Town Ln for a report of a stolen auto. The reporting party told officers that sometime between 8:00PM on August 20<sup>th</sup> and 11:30AM on August 21<sup>st</sup>, someone stole a blue Tao Tao moped from a fenced-in area of the backyard. The moped was valued at \$2000,00.

**Burglary**

At approximately 3:20AM on August 22<sup>nd</sup>, Manassas City Police responded to China Star Restaurant (9917 Wellington Rd) in reference to an alarm. Upon arrival, officers discovered the front door glass had been broken. The owner reported a cash register containing an undisclosed amount of cash and a laptop computer valued at \$300.00 were stolen. Damage to the door is estimated at \$700.00. There was also an excess of litter including beer bottles found around the building since the trailer was last seen secure on Friday.
