Adam A. Fink Convicted of Various Crimes Stemming from 2014 Investigation

September 4, 2015

On September 3, 2015, a jury found Adam A. FINK, 22, guilty of Malicious Wounding by Mob, Attempted Robbery, Use of a Firearm in the Commission of an Attempted Robbery, Carnal Knowledge of a child between the ages of 13 and 15, Attempted Burglary, and Felony Destruction of Property in Prince William County Circuit Court, and recommended a sentence of 26 years in prison and a \$130,000.00 fine. Final sentencing for FINK will take place on December 10, 2015. A charge of Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon is still pending. The case was prosecuted by the Prince William County Commonwealth's Attorney's Office.

FINK's charges were the result of a three-month investigation led by [Manassas City Police](#) and [City of Manassas Park Police](#) working in collaboration with the [Northern Virginia Regional Gang Task Force](#), [Prince William County Police](#), and the [Prince William County Adult Detention Center](#) that concluded in May of 2014. The investigation that led to FINK's arrest peaked with the execution of four search warrants in Manassas, Manassas Park, and Prince William County that resulted in the issuance of ninety-four (94) felony charges against a total of five suspects, three of which pled guilty to gang participation due to their affiliation with the Bloods criminal street gang. The remaining four defendants, Michael MARSHALL (19), Jose Orellana ESCOBAR (27), a 15-year-old male juvenile, and a 17-year-old male juvenile, pled guilty to a total of twenty charges earlier in 2015.
