Larceny from Motor Vehicle

On Oct. 31, 2015, Manassas City Police responded to the 9300 block of Birchwood Ct for a report of a larceny from vehicle. The reporting party told officers that sometime between 10:30 p.m. on Oct. 30 and 8 a.m. on Oct. 31, someone smashed the rear passenger side window of her vehicle and stole bags of baby clothes and an undisclosed amount of cash. Total damages and stolen goods were estimated at \$450.

Larceny from Motor Vehicle

On Oct. 27, 2015, Manassas City Police met with a resident for a report of a larceny from vehicle. The reporting party told officers that someone stole her purse out of her unlocked vehicle while it was parked at Bethel Evangelical Lutheran Church (8712 Plantation Ln) between 10:30 p.m. and 11 p.m. Among the stolen items was an iPhone 6 valued at \$500.

Attempted Breaking & Entering

At approximately 11:30 p.m. on Oct. 30, 2015, Manassas City Police responded to the 9400 block of Stilson Dr for a report of an attempted breaking and entering. The reporting party told officers that moments prior to their arrival, he was alerted to someone on the porch by his barking dog. The unknown male suspect on the porch then yelled and pushed the front door, demanding that the resident allow him inside. When the victim refused, the suspect smashed several planters on the porch, causing \$125 in damage, before fleeing in a gray/silver sedan headed towards Tillett Loop.

Description of suspect: Light-skinned black male, early-mid 20s, wearing a gray jacket with red trim and light gray pants
