

**Manassas City Police Department

Larceny from Motor Vehicle

On Nov. 11, 2015, Manassas City Police met with a resident for a report of a larceny from vehicle that occurred on the 9600 block of Ellicott Ln. The reporting party told officers that sometime between midnight and 9 a.m. on Nov. 11, someone stole a laptop valued at \$1,500, an undisclosed amount of cash, and car keys from his vehicle. It is unknown whether the vehicle was locked at the time of the theft.

Assault & Battery

At approximately 1:40 p.m. on Nov. 8, 2015, Manassas City Police responded to H Mart (8819 Centreville Rd) for a report of an assault and battery. The reporting employee told officers that he observed two juvenile males attempted to shoplift \$45 worth of alcohol from the store and tried to intervene. The employee followed the suspects into the parking lot after they exited the store, where he was struck in the face by one of the suspects and sustained minor injuries. Officers were able to identify the two suspects as two 17-year-old males of Manassas and conducted search warrant at 8804 Antonia Ave where they located the stolen items. The suspects were released into the custody of their parents after being shortly detained. Charges are pending.

Theft of Motor Vehicle Parts

On Nov. 10, 2015, Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 9500 block of Main St for a report of a theft. The reporting party told officers that sometime overnight, the front bumper and license plate were stolen off of his 2006 Ford F250 pickup truck.

Robbery

On Nov. 9, 2015, Manassas City Police responded to the 9700 block of Beech Pl in reference to a robbery. The victim, a 12-year-old male of Manassas, told officers that he was walking near the pavilion on Taney Rd at approximately 3:00 p.m. when he was approached by three unknown subjects. One of the subjects forcefully took the victim's backpack and rifled through it before removing a rain jacket valued at \$90. The suspect then fled on foot with the other two suspects in the direction of Grant Ave.

Description of suspects: (1) Light-skinned or mixed race male, 16-17yo, five-foot-six to five-foot-eight, with green eyes and a short blonde afro on top that faded to brown on the sides and then to black at the base of his head, wearing a blue t-shirt; (2) Black male, 15-18yo, tall with curly hair; (3) Black male, 15-18yo, wearing a black rain jacket and blue jeans

Larceny from a Motor Vehicle

On Nov. 10, 2015, Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 8400 block of Dorsey Cir for a report of a larceny. The reporting party told officers that she had locked her purse in her vehicle between 8:30 p.m. and 9:45 p.m. on Nov. 9. The morning of Nov. 10, the victim discovered her purse missing from her vehicle. After searching the immediate area, the victim located the purse on the ground in an adjacent area with several items missing. Among the stolen items were identification and bank cards, a checkbook, and an undisclosed amount of cash.
