**Robbery**

At approximately 9 p.m. on Dec. 23, 2015, Manassas City Police responded to Hair Cuttery (10072 Dumfries Rd) in reference to an armed robbery that had just occurred. The reporting party told officers that just moments prior, a male subject entered the store, implied that he had a gun, and demanded money from a store employee. The employee complied, and the suspect fled on foot with an undisclosed amount of cash towards the parking lot at Giant (10100 Dumfries Rd).

*Description of suspect:* Black male, late 20s - early 30s, 5'8", 170lbs, deep voice. Wearing a green woodland camouflage shirt buttoned at the top (similar to an Army battle dress uniform (BDU) top), dark gray cargo pants, a black balaclava-style/ski mask and thick black gloves.

**Larcenies from Auto**

On Dec. 24, 2015, Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 8300 block of Tillett Loop for a report of a larceny from auto. The reporting party told officers that sometime between 7 p.m. on Dec. 23 and 11 a.m. on Dec. 24, someone entered her unlocked vehicle and stole her wallet and an iPod valued at \$20.

On Dec. 24, 2015, Manassas City Police met with a resident on the 8900 block of Longstreet Dr for a report of a larceny from auto. The reporting party told officers that sometime between 3:30 p.m. on Dec. 23 and 8:30 a.m. on Dec. 24, someone entered her vehicle and rummaged through the center console, from which an undisclosed amount of cash was reported stolen. There were no signs of forced entry into the vehicle.
