28th Year of MCPD's Cold Case Investigation into the Disappearance of Jerry Plaster

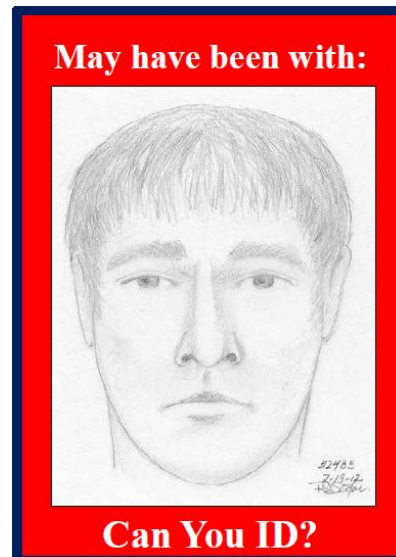
April 16, 2016

Saturday, April 16, 2016 will mark the 28th anniversary of the disappearance of Jerry D. PLASTER, who was last seen on April 16, 1988. At age 25, PLASTER left home to go Manassas Mall (8300 Sudley Rd) and has not been seen since. This year, Manassas City Police is releasing additional information regarding this cold case: a sketch drawn in 2012 portraying a male subject with whom PLASTER may have been just before he went missing, and who might have information pertaining to PLASTER's whereabouts.

Manassas City Police Department continues to follow leads regarding PLASTER's disappearance. Anyone with knowledge of PLASTER's whereabouts, the identity of the subject in the sketch, or other pertinent information related to this case is asked to call the Manassas City Police Investigative Services Division at 703-257-8092.

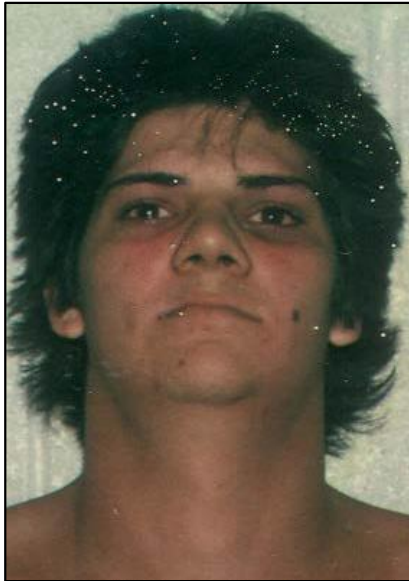
