Vandalism

The victim told officers someone threw a rock at her vehicle, causing approximately \$500.00 in damage to the passenger side rear window. Larceny from Auto

Crime Prevention Tip: Always Lock Your Vehicles. Tips for Protecting Valuables:

Remove all items of value such as handbags, wallets, cell phones, MP3 players, laptops, and other electronics from your car when you are not driving. Take out removable radios and faceplates. The glove box and center console are usually the first place thieves look, so avoid leaving anything inside either one that they could get their hands on. Rather than covering items in your car with a blanket or jacket, take them with you. If you must leave them in your car, place them in the trunk prior to arriving at your destination so no one sees you doing it. Close all car windows completely and park in a well-lit area that is rich in foot traffic and close to your destination. Avoid parking between large vehicles that can provide cover for thieves. Defend yourself and your property at home using outdoor lighting, and take advantage of free security assessments offered through Manassas City Police Department. Make a decision not to become the target of crime, and report any suspicious activity to the police by dialing 703-257-8000. If you are witnessing a crime in progress or a dangerous situation, call 9-1-1 immediately.
