### **Burglary:**

On January 15, 2018 at 7:31 p.m., officers responded to the 8900 block of Sweetbriar Ct for a report of a burglary. The investigation revealed forced entry was made through a back door to the residence sometime between 9:00 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. on January 15<sup>th</sup>. A handgun, cash, and jewelry were reported missing. The investigation is ongoing at this time.

### **Attempted Burglary:**

On January 16, 2018 at 10:04 a.m., officers from the Manassas City Police Department responded to 9216 Center St (Crossroads Realtors) for a report of an attempted burglary. An employee of the business told police sometime between 5:15 p.m. on January 15<sup>th</sup> and 9:00 a.m. on January 16<sup>th</sup> someone attempted to enter the business. During the investigation pry marks were located near the lock on the door to the business. It is believed the suspect was unable to make entry into the business. The investigation is ongoing.

### **Peeping Tom:**

On January 16, 2018 at approximately 8:47 a.m., the Manassas City Police Department received a report of a “peeping tom” at a residence on the 9100 block of Portner Ave. The victim stated she was in the bathroom at 6:30 a.m. when she observed a male subject holding a cellphone up to the bathroom window. Upon being noticed by the victim, the suspect fled the area. The victim was unable to provide a suspect description.

### **Larceny:**

On January 14, 2018 at approximately 9:35 a.m., the Manassas City Police Department responded to 9271 Sudley Rd (Walgreens) for a report of a larceny. The victim advised she left her wallet in a shopping cart. The victim returned to the store and the wallet was missing. The incident occurred sometime between 9:03 a.m. and 9:18 a.m. on January 14<sup>th</sup>.
