Burglary

On February 12, 2018 at approximately 3:24 a.m., officers from the Manassas City Police Department responded to 8765 Mathis Ave (Jewelry Etcetera by Olga) for an alarm activation. Upon arrival, officers discovered forced entry was made through the front window of the business. Further investigation revealed the suspect also attempted to shatter a glass jewelry case inside the business, but was unsuccessful. No items were reported missing.

Hit and Run

On February 13, 2018 at approximately 8:00 a.m., an officer responded to 9100 Euclid Ave for a report of a hit and run. Through investigation it was determined the suspect vehicle backed into the rear of the victim's vehicle and fled the scene. Witnesses observed the suspect vehicle, a white van with Maryland license plates, leave the scene.

Indecent Exposure

On February 14, 2018 at approximately 7:11 p.m., officers responded to the 9700 block of Clark Pl for a report of an indecent exposure. The victim told police she observed a male subject exposing himself outside of the first floor window of her residence. The suspect then fled the area on foot. The suspect is described as a white male approximately 18-years-old, wearing a black bandanna covering the lower portion of his face.

Burglary

On February 15, 2018 at approximately 10:39 p.m., officers responded to 8550 Sudley Rd (Public Storage) for a report of a burglary. The investigation revealed forced entry was made through the ceiling of a storage unit at this location. A television was reported stolen. The incident occurred sometime between January 21, 2018 and February 15, 2018.
