Larceny from Motor Vehicle

On April 30, 2018 at approximately 9:49 a.m., an officer of the Manassas City Police Department responded to the 9200 block of Azure Ct for a report of a larceny from a motor vehicle. The investigation revealed an undisclosed amount of cash was stolen from the victim's vehicle between 5:00 pm on April 29 and the morning hours of April 30. There were no signs of forced entry.

Malicious Wounding

On April 29, 2018 at approximately 10:10 p.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to 8691 Phoenix Dr (Super 8 Motel) for a report of a stabbing. Through investigation it was determined the suspect and victim were involved in a verbal altercation which escalated and the suspect stabbed the victim. The suspect fled the scene prior to police arrival, but was identified as Phillip Edwin PALMER and later arrested. The victim sustained non-life-threatening injuries and was transported to a local area hospital.

On April 29, 2018, an officer of the Manassas City Police Department met with a complainant for a report of a larceny. The victim told police, sometime between 8:45 a.m. and 9:30 a.m., he left his wallet on the counter by the cash register at the 7-Eleven located at 8901 Godwin Dr. Upon returning to the store, the victim discovered the wallet had been stolen. A suspect was identified through surveillance video as a white male between 55-65 years-of-age driving a late model silver Ford Explorer.
