### Shots Fired

On July 16, 2018 at approximately 10:57 p.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to the 8800 block of Antonia Way for a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed that several shots were fired at an occupied residence in the area. Residents of the house were unable to provide a suspect or vehicle description. No injuries and minor damage was reported. The incident does not appear random.

### Larcenies

On July 14, 2018 at approximately 11:19 a.m., an officer of the Manassas City Police Department responded to 9946 Liberia Ave (LA Fitness) for reports of larcenies. Through investigation it was determined several lockers in the men’s locker room were forcibly entered. Victims reported cash, identification, and other miscellaneous items stolen. The incidents are believed to have occurred between 10:17 a.m. and 11:19 a.m. on July 14<sup>th</sup>.

### Fatal Hit and Run

On July 14, 2018 at approximately 2:11 a.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to the area of Dumfries Rd and Winterset Dr for a report of a hit and run involving a pedestrian. During the investigation, it was determined the victim was crossing Dumfries Rd on foot when he was struck by a vehicle travelling northbound on Dumfries Rd. The suspect vehicle fled the scene, but the driver was later identified. The victim was transported to a local area hospital where he succumbed to his injuries. The victim is identified as FOY, Lashun a 28 year-old resident of Manassas. The investigation is on-going.

### Vehicle Break-in

On July 14, 2018 at approximately 11:50 p.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to the 10000 block of Cleary St for a report of a vehicle break-in. A witness observed the suspect rummaging through a vehicle. Upon being discovered, the suspect fled the area. The victim reported debit cards stolen. The suspect was later identified by police and arrest warrants were obtained.
