### **Hit and Run/Assault on LEO**

On September 1, 2018 at approximately 8:59 p.m., officers from the Manassas City Police Department responded to the 8800 block of Jackson Ave for a report of a hit and run. Through investigation, it was determined the suspects were travelling on Jackson Ave when the driver lost control of the vehicle and crashed into a residence. The driver and passenger fled the scene, but were located by officers nearby. The passenger, a juvenile, was uncooperative and assaulted officers during the course of the investigation and was subsequently arrested. The driver, identified as Jose MARTINEZ, was cited and released. The juvenile passenger was treated for minor injuries from the crash and the officers were uninjured.
