Larceny from Automobile

On February 6, 2019, at 6:50 a.m., an officer of the Manassas City Police Department responded to the 9800 block of Gillum Way for a report of a larceny from automobile. The victim told police an unknown suspect had forcibly entered a rear door to their work truck which had been locked the prior evening. Miscellaneous tools, to include multiple drills and a reciprocating saw, were reported stolen. It is believed the suspect broke a pad lock to gain access to the rear door of the truck. The investigation is ongoing.

Larceny from Automobile

On February 6, 2019, at 2:47 p.m., an officer of the Manassas City Police Department responded to the 9300 block of Wax Myrtle Way for a report of a larceny from automobile. The victim told police they had parked their vehicle near the intersection of Wax Myrtle Way and Fringe Tree Ln at approximately 11:40 a.m. on February 6, 2019. When the victim returned to their car a few hours later, they noticed contents missing. Cash and a Smith and Wesson handgun were reported stolen. The investigation is ongoing.

Larceny

On February 6, 2019, at 8:50 p.m., an officer of the Manassas City Police Department responded to the 8700 block of Deblanc Pl for a report of a larceny. The victim told police their Cub Cadet snow blower valued at \$1,200 was stolen from their backyard. It is believed the suspect unlatched the rear gate of the backyard fence to steal the snow blower. Physical evidence was examined and processed at the scene. The investigation is ongoing.
