Prescription Drug Take-Back April 27, 2019

On April 27, 2019 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., the Manassas City Police Department will be partnering with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and the Prince William County Police Department to provide the public a safe, convenient, and anonymous way to dispose of unused and unwanted medication. Often, abused prescription drugs are obtained from family, friends, and medicine cabinets. Help prevent addiction and drug abuse by disposing of your unwanted and unused medication at a DEA Drug Take-Back site. The City of Manassas drop-off site will be located at:
