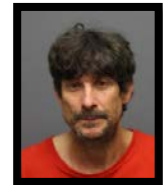
Grand Larceny

On May 25, 2019 at approximately 12:36 p.m., an officer of the Manassas City Police Department responded to 9030 Mathis Ave (Big Coin Laundry) for a report of a larceny. The victim reported he accidentally left his wallet inside the business. When the victim returned to the business, he found the wallet, but discovered a large amount of cash inside the wallet had been stolen. Security footage identified the suspect as an unknown white male between 60-80 years of age.

Driving While Intoxicated/Hit and Run

On May 26, 2019 at approximately 2:22 a.m., the Manassas City Police Department received a report of a hit and run that had occurred in the 9600 block of Grant Ave. Officers observed the suspect vehicle driving at a high-rate of speed in the area. Officers then observed the suspect vehicle wreck in the 10000 block of Dumfries Rd. The suspect was not injured in the accident and was taken into custody. The victim of the hit and run reported minor damage to their vehicle.
