## **Burglary**

On January 30 at approximately 1:15 p.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to a residence in the 9000 block of Longstreet Drive for a report of a burglary. The investigation revealed the suspect(s) forced entry into the residence. Several rooms inside the residence were rummaged through. Cash and other items were reported stolen. The incident is believed to have occurred between 8:30 a.m. and 1:15 p.m. on January 30. The investigation is on-going.

## **Robbery**

On January 28 at approximately 5:17 p.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department met with a victim for a report of a robbery. The victim, a juvenile male, told police he had been walking in the area behind Scarlet Oak Drive with juveniles he had met through Snapchat when one of the juveniles demanded money from the victim. The victim complied and the suspects fled the area. The investigation is on-going.
