Shots Fired

On April 14 at approximately 6:27 p.m. officers responded to the area of the 9600 block of Main Street for a report of shots fired. A witness reported seeing a subject fire shots from a vehicle towards unknown individuals. The vehicle was located by officers nearby in the area of Dumfries Road and Grant Avenue. One suspect was arrested. No injuries and no property damage were reported. The incident does not appear random.

Previously Released:

On April 12 at approximately 10:12 p.m. officers responded to the area of Taney Road for a report of shots fired. The investigation revealed 3-4 Hispanic males were walking in the area of Byrd Drive and Bragg Lane. Two of the males fired multiple shots into the air. The suspects were not located. No injuries were reported. The investigation is on-going.
