Breaking & Entering

On June 7 at approximately 9:47 a.m., an officer of the Manassas City Police Department responded to 9509 Lee Court (Virginia Portuguese Community Center) for a report of a break-in. The investigation revealed forced entry was made through a side door. Bottles of liquor were reported stolen. The incident is believed to have occurred between 8 p.m. on June 6 and 8 a.m. on June 7. The business sustained minor damage.

Malicious Wounding

On June 7 at approximately 11:15 a.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to 9913 Cockrell Road (Homestyle Inn) for a report of a stabbing. Responding officers located an adult male victim with a stab wound. The investigation revealed the victim and suspect were involved in a verbal altercation which escalated and the suspect stabbed the victim. The suspect fled the scene prior to police arrival. The victim sustained non-life-threatening injuries. The suspect, William Dimetrius HARRIS, is wanted for malicious wounding.

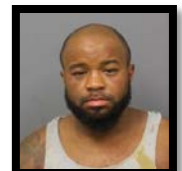
Malicious Wounding

On June 7 at approximately 1:32 a.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to 9413 Main Street (The Philadelphia Tavern) for a report of a physical altercation. The investigation revealed the suspects, later identified as Davario Valente BATES and Sean Bernard LEE Jr., were involved in a physical altercation and the two victims attempted to break-up the fight. During the encounter, BATES struck one of the victims with a bottle and the other victim was struck by LEE. Both suspects were taken into custody and charged. The victims sustained minor injuries.
