



The City of Manassas' annual program of flushing water mains will begin on April 8, 2019 and will take three to four weeks to complete. Our crews will be flushing hydrants weekdays between 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

This program helps to remove sediment from our mains that may have accumulated over the past several months. It also allows us the opportunity to operate many of our fire hydrants to determine if additional maintenance is needed.

Some discoloration of water may be noticed during the flushing of mains in your area. This condition is not harmful and should clear up quickly by running your cold water for a short period of time. It is recommended that you limit your clothes washing during the flushing hours and that you follow guidelines for aquatic environments like aquariums.
