- This **EROSION CONTROL PERMIT** allows clearing, grading and the installation of Erosion Control devices. These devices must be installed as the first step in any land disturbing activity. The City of Manassas shall accept these devices prior to other land disturbing activities that may take place on the site.
- This **LAND DISTURBING PERMIT** allows clearing and grading only. This permit will not be released until the appropriate bonds are posted or the site has been restabilized. The Erosion Control devices must be installed as the first step in any land disturbing activity. The City of Manassas shall accept these devices prior to other land disturbing activities that may take place on the site.

If the permit holder does not comply with the above- mentioned stipulations, then this permit will be voided and a **STOP WORK ORDER** will be issued. Facilitation of bond release will be pending the City of Manassas' final approval of the disturbed site.
